

Boosting Agriculture and Food Security (BAFS)



BAFS Support to MAF **Forestry Division**: Community Based Forestry (CBF)



- ✓ Identification and selection of forest sites using international standards and best practices
- ✓ At least 60 community people sensitized on the processes, principles and practices of CBF and inclusive forest land tenure
- ✓ Sensitization of inhabitants of neighboring villages on land tenure governance and participatory forest management at least 5 villages in each of the 4 districts
- ✓ Formation and training of 11 Community Forest
 Management Committees in each of the four districts
- ✓ Identification and training of 7 "forest monitors" in each district
- ✓ Formation of 5 Community Forest Development Association
- ✓ Administration of preliminary Community Forest Management Agreement (PCFMA) for community, chiefdom and district stakeholders
- ✓ Boundary demarcation, participatory mapping forest sites and community woodlots, production of CBF maps
- ✓ Assessment of bio-diversity in 3 CBF areas
- ✓ Analysis of alternative livelihood options in communities and development of sustainability plans in 4 CBF areas

Support to afforestation, agroforestry & community woodlots:

- Establishment of 120 acres of legumes/cereal crops as an alternative source of income to forest communities
- Establishment of 40,000 seedlings for agro-forestry, afforestation and alternative livelihoods (10,000 per CBF site)
 - Timber trees (Tectona Grandis, Terminalia Ivorenses, Gmelina Aborea), Cashew, Tamarine and fruit seeds
